The foundation of risk management is knowledge of the factors which may cause loss. Cyber security is no different.

Cyber breaches are increasing and being reported daily. The information though, does not offer real answers.

In the first quarter of 2018 breaches reported to the Australian Government under the Notifiable Data Breaches scheme showed that the Health sector accounted for 24% of the total number breaches followed by Legal and Accounting at 16% and Financial Services including Superannuation 13%. The reporting began in February 2018 and the breaches are exponential.

Cyber Security is about Risk Minimisation and Asset Protection, it is no different from other parts of business where assessment of risk in order to minimise potential impact is undertaken. Traditional security solutions such as
